Hey Howard,

I've looked at the government committees, Ethics & Standards come under the Public Administration Select Committee.

The Public Administration Select Committee was established by the House of Commons in June 2010 for the duration of the 2010-2015 Parliament. Its remit was to consider matters relating to the quality and standards of administration within the Civil Service.

On 3 June 2015 the House of Commons approved changes to Standing Orders to establish a <u>Public Administration and Constitutional Affairs</u> Committee with a remit to examine:

- a) reports of the Parliamentary and Health Service Ombudsman and connected matters
- b) the quality of civil service administration and other related matters
- c) constitutional affairs.

The Public Administration Select Committee (PASC) examines the quality and standards of administration within the Civil Service and scrutinises the reports of the Parliamentary and Health Service Ombudsman.

We are a committee of Members of Parliament appointed by the House of Commons and drawn from the three largest political parties. We work principally by undertaking inquiries. We choose our own subjects of inquiry and seek evidence from a wide range of groups and individuals with relevant interests and experience. We produce reports setting out our findings and making recommendations to the Government. We monitor complaints about the Ombudsman as a way of scrutinising the work of her office and identifying systemic problems, but **we will not consider individual cases**.
