Dear Prime Minister,

I am sorry that you have not decided to stand by children with special needs who have been abused by the system. If you non-diagnose or wrongly diagnose, then label them as naughty, you set them on a course that will damage and isolate them to the point where they are not educated and traumatically stressed. This affects the rest of their lives negatively as I have seen in my case study. Shirking responsibility and blaming the mother is never the correct solution.

You have not complied with the complaints' procedure, transparency legislation, or disabilities and equal opportunities law. You have flatly refused to comply by not supplying the relevant paperwork, even though asked and reminded. You and your Government can only be seen as perverting the course of justice, potentially a criminal offence. Your back-room staff will have investigated and have seen the truth, then gone out of their way not to deal with it; yet the children still suffer. This is not democracy as it was meant to be. You and your cabinet have suppressed complaints about child abuse when all complaints have to be investigated by law. Why haven't you done so? I have requested an independent (from Parliament) investigation from both yourself and Mrs May. Seemingly this is the last thing you want, otherwise it would have happened by now, unless it already has and it was suppressed. This would be perverting the rights of those who need them most, again! I would suggest that these are not the actions of a Right Honourable gentleman – if you had nothing to hide you would have been transparent as per the law.

Toughing it out is not the answer as too many people know what has happened (Justice for Autism website.) I hope that common sense will prevail and correct contact is made soon. I understand that perverting justice would open potential prosecution. Your job however is for the greater good and not self-preservation. My understanding of nonand wrong diagnosis as a clinician is that it leads to malpractice where you could be struck off or imprisoned. As for covering it up, an MP who lied about points on his wife's licence went to jail for perverting the course of justice; covering up child abuse is much worse.
