Dear Prime Minister,

I hope that your belated wedding party and leaving do went well. I expect that you have been too busy to deal with my correspondence but with the Telford and teen baby scandals where cover-up was the norm, I feel I have to ask the question: how long have you known about the abusive system you head? Also why do you feel that a small tinker with education would solve the hardship of hundreds of thousands of systematically traumatically stressed children? Many of these have been taken from their homes and families, not given the diagnosis or correct treatments, and held without charge or understood diagnosis for years without the hope for parole.

Child abuse is a crime; perverting justice to cover it up is a huge abuse of power and aids and abets the crime. I believe you truly feel that you have no responsibility for any of this, and that you have two sets of rules – one where you think that you are untouchable, and the other one that everyone else has to follow.

If you check back through my correspondence, you will see that I have not only been trying to get all of the paperwork back and point out a few of the laws that you as a Government have been breaking, but also to get an independent investigation. You have clearly refused this, and after the release of the independent inquiry into Telford and the Human Rights Committee findings I can understand why.

Let us face it, poor people and those who have been traumatically stressed or who have special needs generally do not vote, but this does not mean that they can be abused because they have no voice. There is much more to good government than balance sheets and ballot boxes. Keeping capitalists under control to protect those who have not had good fortune in life should always be a priority. After all, that is what your sworn oath was about, not just words.

In your last days at the helm, I would hope that you see the light and organise a deep investigation into the Cabinet's offices and Privy Council to get to the bottom of this vast injustice that has gone on for decades now. If not, I am afraid that I will have to add you to the list for the ICC and others once you leave office.

Please get the Cabinet Secretary to look at the criteria for crimes against humanity before this letter is ignored.
