Dear Prime Minister,

The Ministerial Code, as you will know, sets out rules and standards for government. They were a response to the erosion of ministerial accountability, to try and preserve public trust. Overseen by the Propriety and Ethics Group, part of the Cabinet Office, so not independent.

The Code states—ministers must behave in a way that upholds the highest standards of propriety (or morals). Upholding collective responsibility, be truthful and correcting mistakes or errors.
