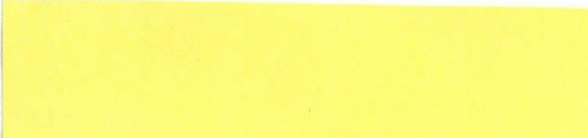
Dear Mr Lamb,
